

Hecht Preserve



The 47 acre Hecht Preserve was purchased in 2O23 from John & Mary Belter and Helen Belter Hill. Funding was provided by the State of CT Open Space & Watershed Land Acquisition Program and the Anne & Rollin Bates Foundation.

The preserve is named in honor of Lou & Elaine Hecht in gratitude for exceptional and ongoing support of the Land Trust. Lou was co-chair of the Land Trust for 17 years. Both Elaine & Lou have written and designed many environmental educational exhibits and devoted countless hours to preserving important landscapes.

The 1.3 mile loop trail starts at the town Wack Forest.

Parking for several cars is off Rt 112 about 4/10 mile west of Wells Hill road.
